Can be expected to reach occupational competence by the end of the apprenticeship

There are no minimum requirements in the standard that are higher than the minimum apprenticeship requirements

Can be expected to achieve Entry Level 3 by the end of the apprenticeship

An evidenced assessment demonstrates that even with support, reasonable adjustments and stepping stone qualifications the apprentice is not able to achieve the minimum requirements

Has an Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plan

Has a Statement of Special Educational Needs (SEN) The minimum English and maths requirements needed to complete an apprenticeship have been adjusted to Entry level 3 functional skills (instead of level 1 or 2 as listed in the apprenticeship standard) for a defined group of people with learning difficulties and disabilities.
