TOP TIPS FOR EMPLOYERS

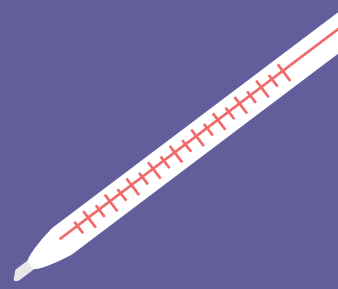
1 IDENTIFY A GOOD, LOCAL TRAINING PROVIDER - EITHER THROUGH RECOMMENDATIONS OR SEARCHING ONLINE.



2 HAVING INTERVIEWED AND SELECTED A NEW APPRENTICE - CONSIDER A ONE WEEK WORK TRIAL (PRIOR TO STARTING THE ROLE) SO THAT THEY CAN SEE WHETHER IT IS FOR THEM.



3 FOR A NEW APPRENTICE, YOU COULD CONSIDER A SLIDING SCALE SALARY WHERE THEIR PAY IS INCREASED ON ACHIEVEMENT OF CERTAIN GOALS.



4 CONSIDER A YOUNG APPRENTICE TO TACKLE AN AGEING WORKFORCE.



5 PROVIDE A WORK BUDDY TO HELP THE APPRENTICE WITH DIRECTION, QUESTIONS AND SUPPORT.



6 ENCOURAGE EXISTING STAFF TO CONSIDER AN APPRENTICESHIP QUALIFICATION TO HELP WITH THEIR DEVELOPMENT AND CAREER PROGRESSION.
