T Levels will provide a progression pathway to higher or degree-level apprenticeships, higher-level education and skilled employment

T Levels are taught full time with a mixture of classroom learning and 'on-the-job' experience which will take place as an industry placement of at least 315 hours (approximately 45 days)\*

Two-year technical courses

One T Level is equivalent to 3

A levels

## T Levels

What are they?

Expected to take 1,800 hours to complete

On completion of a T Level course, UCAS points will be awarded Technical alternative to A levels

Aimed at 16-18 year olds

\*Although students will complete their industry placement in an employment setting, they will not be an employee and do not require to be paid.

The first T Level courses will launch in September 2020.
