Where can I find Apprenticeship vacancies in the health sector?

As an apprentice you will be employed so vacancies will be advertised. We recommend looking at [NHS Jobs](#) or the government's [Apply for an Apprenticeship website](#) for current vacancies.

As with all jobs, applying for an apprenticeship is a competitive process. You will be required to complete an application form or submit a CV and go through a formal selection process.

Do I meet the entry requirements?

Entry requirements for each apprenticeship will be different. For roles in the NHS the [Health Careers website](#) contains information on what employers will commonly expect in terms of entry requirements. For apprenticeships and especially those for healthcare professionals such as Physiotherapist or Paramedic you will also need to be able to demonstrate you are able to meet the academic demands of the programme such as studying for a Degree.
