## Background

### Awards and Further Competitions

Please note that all Universities / Programmes listed above are their offerings at time of creating the Framework (September 2020). Employers are able to conduct a further competition amongst all Universities should they need to, which may result in any of the Framework providers offering a new course / variant in addition to those they have already submitted.

In all cases, any subsequent award is conditional upon the University obtaining (and maintaining) NMC approval where required.

When the Framework Summary Spreadsheet is requested by Employers, this also lists Providers by regions offered. This again may be subject to change if employers create a suitably large cohort and therefore regions are listed as indicative rather than restrictive.

### Accessing Providers

Organisations wishing to use the Framework should, in the first instance, contact the named point at the top of this information sheet. Organisations will not need to complete a separate Access Agreement. Salisbury will then provide the Provider(s)' Bid Response and the Employer can then Direct Award using Salisbury's Unique Reference Number form available on request, or can conduct a further competition between their regional or the national providers using local criteria, carried out on their behalf by Salisbury's team.

### Contracting

Contracts will be under NHS Terms & Conditions, with Provider bid response, commercial response, and Employer/Provider written agreements already inserted. Employers can then complete the Contract Call Off and exchange with their selected provider, with a copy to Salisbury. Employers and Providers then need to report learner start numbers to Salisbury throughout the life of the Framework contract. **Please note contracts with providers through this Framework are not valid unless bearing a Salisbury Unique Reference Number issued at the time of employer request.**
