## PAMELA DULEY REGISTERED NURSE DEGREE APPRENTICESHIP

We spoke with Pamela about her journey as a Registered Nurse Degree apprentice working in the Health Visiting team, keep reading to find out more.

### WHAT APPRENTICESHIP ARE YOU STUDYING AND WHAT DOES THE STUDY INVOLVE?

---

I'm studying the Registered Nurse Degree Apprenticeship, Adult Nursing. After completing a Nursing Associate Apprenticeship, I was awarded a place to become a Registered Nurse Degree apprentice which meant I joined the BSc Adult Nursing Degree in year 2.

It is a full time course and involves a mixture of academic study and working in placements in different areas of nursing.

### WHAT DOES YOUR JOB ROLE INVOLVE?

---

My job involves working with families with children under the age of five, supporting them with a wide range of parenting and health issues from breastfeeding difficulties, behaviour management, advising at well baby clinics and assessing child development.

Health visitors would refer a family to me and I would liaise with them about the intervention needed.

### WHY DID YOU WANT TO DO AN APPRENTICESHIP?

---

I had progressed as far as I could in my career with the qualification I had and wanted to progress further.

### WHAT DO YOU WANT TO DO ONCE YOU QUALIFY?

---

I would like to be a community nurse as I really enjoyed my placement with them. I love being out and about in the community and seeing people in their own homes especially in rural areas as I'm a 'country' girl and understand some of the issues of living in a rural area.
