Levy Transfer - Sending

- Did you know that, as a Levy-paying organisation, you can transfer some of your funds to help others? You can transfer up to 25%. Your transfer allowance is calculated as 25% of your previous financial year's apprenticeship levy funds.
- You can choose to transfer your levy funds to any business.
 Any business can receive a transfer of levy funds, including businesses that pay the apprenticeship levy and those that do not.
- A transfer of levy funds is not a one-off payment. By agreeing to transfer levy funds to another business, you are committing to pay for a specific apprenticeship over the course of its duration until the apprenticeship has been completed.
- If you pay the apprenticeship levy you can transfer your levy funds using your <u>apprenticeship service account.</u>
- There are 2 ways of making a transfer:
 - 1. Pledge and transfer your levy funds so other businesses can apply to you for funding
 - 2. Make a transfer to a business you know by inviting them to make a connection
