# **CAREER STARTER APPRENTICESHIPS** INTERNATIONAL FREIGHT FORWARDING SPECIALIST LEVEL 3

A freight forwarding apprentice will organise shipments to move goods from the manufacturer or producer to a market, customer or final point of distribution. You will be involved in the logistics network, often working with a variety of shipping modes, including ships, aeroplanes, lorries, and railroads.

#### **TYPICAL TASKS COULD INCLUDE:**

- Shipment booking and transport requirements
- Preparing and submitting customs declarations to HMRC
- Liaison with carriers, ports and handling agents around the world
- Sales quotations, invoicing and financial procedures

Once you have completed your apprenticeship, there will be many pathways your career could take. You could be exporting some of the UK's most valuable products or importing vital goods. The Logistics industry will always be needed and it offers a stimulating and stable future.
